

Privacy Statement at www.valers.co.uk

Overview

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into force on 25th May 2018. Our aim is to comply with the regulations, but bear in mind that we are a small group of volunteers and not a multinational corporation - we don't have a team of Data Controllers here. Having said that, the GDPR takes no prisoners and we are not exempt.

What information do we hold about event organisers?

We hold the minimum amount of information that allows us to keep in contact with you. This typically may include:

- Generic detail such as village location, description, entry cost, postcode etc
- A personal or event email address
- A personal or event phone number

We retain no other information about you.

What information do we publish on www.valers.co.uk?

We only publish information that has been supplied by you, one of your event co-organisers, or a third party. This information is used to promote your event and typically may include:

- Generic detail such as village location, description, entry cost, postcode etc
- A personal or event email address
- A personal or event phone number

The event email address may be the same as your personal email address, if you have instructed us to publish it on the website. The event phone number may be your personal phone number, if you have instructed us to publish it on the website.

How has your information been collected?

All information that we hold will have been supplied by you, your event co-organisers, or a third party, by completing our on-line event submission form. Information is not taken from any other source.

How is your information used?

It is used solely to keep your event information up to date and to allow us to contact you.

How is your information stored?

- On-line at www.valers.co.uk
- Off-line on a PC, laptop computer, other mobile devices, and a backup HD.

Is your information stored or archived as paper/printed copies?

No.

For how long do we retain your information?

Event information is retained on www.valers.co.uk until you ask us to remove it or until we are satisfied that your event no longer runs. After an event has passed, it is no longer displayed on the website but the details may still be retained in our database until it is purged. Elements of your email contact information is retained in the form of archived emails and email threads ('sent items' etc) until it is purged. Purging of out of date event information takes place from time to time.

If you are not an event organiser but have contacted us by email (ie a general enquiry through our website), your email contact information may be retained in the form of archived emails and email threads ('sent items' etc) which is purged at intervals.

Will your information be shared with any third parties?

No, we won't do that, unless instructed to do so by an appropriate authority (police, court order etc). However, if your event has more than one editor, any requests to amend the event information may be copied to other email addresses in the editing group. This ensures the integrity of your event information.

Security

We take all reasonable measures to safeguard the information that you supplied and which is held on our systems, but like all other systems of this kind, the security of your information cannot be guaranteed.

Use of cookies

Session cookies are used on various pages of the website. These are not retained, and are deleted when a browser page is closed. No tracking cookies are utilised.

Removing your information

If you wish to have your contact details or event information removed from our systems, then just send us a simple request by email and we will do so, and will confirm when done.
